

EYFS: Nursery and Reception home Learning

- Sorting objects – size, colour, shape. Now count them in different ways.
- Look for and describe 2D (flat) and 3D (solid) shapes.
- Recognise and sort 1p, 2p, 5p and 10p coins.
- Use a dice to play board games.
- Begin to know days of the week and months of the year. *When is your birthday?*

- Fruit and vegetable taste test.

- Floating and sinking – which vegetables float and which sink?

- Use different materials and found objects to create a beanstalk.
- Go for a colour walk. *How many different shades of one colour can you find?*
- Learn a new song and make some instruments and a dance to accompany your song.
- Make a castle for a giant using recycled materials.
- Role play activities based on first-hand experience. Set up a shop or café or hairdresser or station...
- What do you know about Holy week? Find out more...
- Make an Easter garden or Easter card.
- Tug of war with a towel.
- Wave ribbons around.
- Bounce and catch balls.
- Put on and take off clothes independently. Do up buttons on cardigans or tops.
- Use large tools such as spade, garden fork or trowel and small tools such as scissors or hole punch.
- Try tweezers or clothing pegs to pick up small objects (pompoms, straws, beans, buttons, etc)
- Thread a cord (shoelace, ribbon, etc) through straws or beads.
- Do up and undo nuts and bolts.
- Match and then put lids onto bottles.
- Jigsaw puzzles.
- Wrap parcels (don't worry about neatness).
- Pour from and into containers (water, rice, beans).
- Playdough – rolling, squeezing.
- Begin to write recognisable lower-case letters and numerals.
